

Fun and easy felt leaves for fall decorating. Use as a garland!

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## EMBROIDERED AUTUMN LEAVES



## **MATERIALS:**

Wool felt in several autumn colors (usually found on a bolt, not in the kids craft section)

Embroidery floss in 3 or more colors Embroidery needles 1/8" ribbon (or string) Printable leaf template

## INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1) Print pages 3 &4. Cut at the outer line.
- 2) Trace the leaf shapes onto wool felt and cut the number of leaves desired.
- 3) Trim the paper templates to the smaller size, and cut the same number of corresponding smaller felt leaves. Try to pair them with contrasting colors.
- 4) Using all 6 strands of embroidery floss, thread the needle and tie a knot. Use a running stitch, starting at the back of the stem, and following around the inner leaf edge. Finish by stitching a line up the middle. Or be creative and try your own designs! You can use loose leaves to decorate the mantle or table.







5) To make a garland, use 1/8" ribbon threaded through the embroidery needle to stitch them together. If you use just one small stitch, you will be able to adjust the spacing after you hang the garland.
